





REMEMBERING MALCOLM MATTHEWS

With profound sadness and a heavy heart, we inform you that Mr. Malcolm Matthews, our long-time friend and colleague, has unexpectedly passed away.

Malcolm was a graduate of the Chemical Engineering Class of 1963 at Imperial College London. His affinity for his alma mater remained strong. In 2014, Malcolm and members of this cohort established the first ever scholarship funded by a class of alumni to help ease the financial burden of chemical engineering undergraduates at Imperial College London.

In 1997, Malcolm was serving as the CEO of Hong Kong and China Gas Company (Towngas) when Dr. Harry Lee invited him to join the TAL family as a Board Member. At the time, Dr. Lee and Malcolm were residing in the same building. They became acquainted as they both served on the building's management committee. Dr. Lee recalls that he was deeply impressed by Malcom's poise and composure, as well as his ability to manage complex issues and galvanize people from diverse backgrounds around solutions.



For 27 years, Malcolm proved to be a loyal and highly respected member of the Group. He was a kind and gentle leader who always brought a fresh and unique perspective. Malcolm frequently visited our factories all over the world, meticulously recording all his observations in his notebook and sharing his insights with colleagues in great detail.

Malcolm's impact and legacy will extend far beyond the many significant contributions he made as a Board Director. His generosity and kindness will always be cherished and celebrated by those who had the privilege of working with him. He will be deeply missed, but his influence and spirit will live on through the values and principles he instilled in us all.


